

STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

Warm greetings from the Village Church Stewardship Committee. We are threequarters of the way to our goal of \$1.4 million. Over 150 members have made commitments of all sizes – an enthusiastic response to the many plans for choosing love and making it real. This year's dollar goal is 8% higher than last year's because the Church is investing more in our Service, Learning, Worship, Sharing & Community ministries.

If you have not yet made your pledge or gift, please do so by returning your pledge card. You may also give on-line at <u>wellesleyvillagechurch.org/give</u>. If circumstances allow increasing the size of your commitment, this will accelerate our progress. Pledging now allows the Finance Committee to better manage expenditures. In addition, members of the Stewardship Committee are beginning to follow up, so knowing your intentions will make our job much easier.

As we approach the joyous celebration of Easter, we hope making your "best gift" is an enjoyable process. We are all so fortunate to belong to this special community where we can deepen our faith and practice our values.

CLOISTER WINDOW REPLACEMENT PROJECT

BEHOLD as we live out our values by beautifying the Cloister so that it will BECOME warm and lovely! Rejoice in the Greening of our BELOVED CHURCH!

Today! Take a walk through the Cloister! The windows in our beautiful Cloister are being replaced as part of our environmental efforts to "green" our church. You will have a chance to compare the new with the old.

We expect the project to be completed by the middle of next week. As with any construction project there will be some inconvenience before we get to say "wow" at the finished product. Parking will be limited, there is noise in the cloister, and there will be no access to the cloister, except today.

Cloister Upgrades

Workmen have been removing 70-year-old, single pane windows and doors in the Cloister, and replacing them with custom built Pella high energy efficient insulated dual tempered glass windows and doors. This will greatly reduce the loss of energy in the Cloister.

The second part of the plan, which is being designed, will be to extend the HVAC system from the Chapel to the ceiling of the Cloister to provide both heating and air conditioning to make the space comfortable at all times.

The project is being managed by the Energy Committee which was formed in 2015 to use 10% of the 2014 Capital Appeal (about \$432,000) for the "greening", or in today's terms, the "sustainability" of the Church.

Projects over the past ten years have included the solar arrays on the roof, replacing the sashes of the Parish House windows, insulating the Upper Room, replacing inefficient lighting with more efficient LED lighting and making the existing heating and air conditioning systems (HVAC) as efficient as they can possibly be. Working with the Board of Properties, the Energy Committee will be making recommendations to the Congregation on sustainability upgrades to the HVAC system which is now past its expected useful life.
